Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Early fog over southern England may be slow to clear today, with some patches lingering into the afternoon. Elsewhere, skies will be cloudy, with some occasional brighter breaks. Rain and strong winds will linger in the northwest and it'll become heavier tonight whilst edging southwards. There'll be a risk of frost and fog in the south too.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:  
Rain will sink southwards across Scotland and Northern Ireland on Saturday, with heavy outbreaks. It'll become colder in the north, with occasional wintry showers, but milder and largely dry in the south, and that rain will move away to the south on Sunday.
