

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 1945 on Saturday 02 Feb 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Rain in the west initially will only slowly push east during Sunday, with some heavy rain and coastal gales likely particularly in the west, Eastern England remaining dry until evening. Clear spells and scattered showers will follow to western parts later on Sunday.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Early rain in the east on Monday clearing, otherwise frost and icy patches in many areas to start. Sunny spells, but blustery showers at times, heavy in places with strong winds and possible gales developing. Rain spreading east Monday night, heavy at times, mostly clearing by Tuesday afternoon, but further squally showers to follow in many places.
