Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
For most parts a much colder brighter day with some sunny spells. South Wales, Central Southern and Southwest England will remain generally dry. Elsewhere showers will become increasing widespread and wintry with snow over the hills and to lower levels across Scotland where it will be windy.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Snow developing over the south during Saturday night clearing early on Sunday. Wintry Showers following to all parts with some further longer spells of rain, sleet and snow, especially for the north where several centimeters of snow are possible over the hills. Some sunshine in-between especially over central areas. Cold with night frosts.
