

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A few bright spells and showers, some turning heavy and thundery, and possibly merging into longer spells of rain across northeast England and central and eastern Scotland. Much of England and Wales should become drier overnight, however some rain may persist across northeast England and parts of Scotland. Feeling much cooler across eastern England.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Rain, accompanied by freshening southeasterly winds, will move northeastwards on Monday to affect much of the UK by the evening. However, Scotland should remain largely dry. Further rain or showers will affect many places on Tuesday, and it will feel cool in northeasterly winds.
