

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Southern parts of Britain will be cloudy with rain and drizzle gradually becoming more patchy. Scotland, and Northern England and Ireland will be mainly dry and bright. Northern parts will be dry and cool tonight with clear spells and some patchy fog. Southern parts will be rather cloudy and damp.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

On Tuesday southern areas will be rather cloudy again, though the southwest should brighten up a little later. A few showers for Northern Ireland, otherwise remaining parts will be bright and dry. On Wednesday rain will spread to Northern Ireland while other parts of the country have a dry day.
