

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Early rain clearing southeastwards this morning. Otherwise, sunny spells and blustery showers are expected, some heavy and squally, particularly in the west and north. Showers will be wintry over northern hills, and it will be driest and brightest over eastern England. Showers will increase to rain in the west and north this evening, spreading throughout overnight.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Rain, with snow over Scottish hills for a time, will become briefly heavy before blustery showers and sunny spells spread from the northwest. Strong winds will develop, with gales in some places. Showers are expected on Sunday, some heavy, squally and locally wintry.
