Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
After a grey start northern and eastern areas will brighten up, although it will feel cool in the northerly wind. Elsewhere, it will be another fine day with some warm sunshine, particularly in sheltered western parts of the United Kingdom. However, temperatures will be than yesterday for many. It will turn chilly overnight, with patchy rural frost possible in places.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Tuesday will be rather cloudy across much of England and Wales and the far north of Scotland, with some rain affecting the Northern Isles. Bright with sunny spells elsewhere. It will stay settled on Wednesday, with plenty of warm sunshine.
