Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
Mostly dry at first. Heavy and persistent rain, accompanied by gales or severe gales, soon spreading southeast across Northern Ireland and Scotland, reaching the northwest of both England and Wales by the evening. Elsewhere, mainly dry with some good sunny spells developing though the sunshine becoming rather hazy later. Mild, though not necessarily feeling so in the wind and rain.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Rain over Wales, northern and western England on Friday morning moving southeastwards, finally clearing southeast England during Saturday morning. Sunny spells and showers following from the northwest. Saturday, sunshine and blustery showers for most, rain reaching northwest Britain later. Windy.
