Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Boxing Day will be similar to Christmas Day for most: spells of light rain and drizzle will mainly affect the west, whereas the east will be rather cloudy but drier with some bright intervals. Meanwhile, the far northwest will see heavy rain and severe gales at times. It will remain very mild for most in shelter from the strong wind.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Tuesday will be mostly mild and cloudy, whilst northern Scotland will be colder with rain and hill snow. It will become generally windy and colder on Wednesday, with blustery showers, wintry in the North, with storm-force winds here at times.
