

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Snow showers across eastern Scotland, and northeast England coastal fringes, some significant accumulations expected over higher ground. Elsewhere mainly dry, with sunny spells for after the clearance of any overnight fog. A band of rain preceded by snow will spread northeast across the far southwest late in the day. Becoming windy in the southwest.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Snow in the southwest will spread northeast across Wales, southern England and the Midlands during the morning with some significant snowfalls in places. The snow band will become slow moving across England and Wales producing more significant falls for the rest of Thursday and into Friday.
