Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Today: Showers across N.Ireland and Scotland becoming lighter and isolated, except across west and northern Scotland. Elsewhere mainly dry, just isolated light showers across northern England. Generally bright with sunny intervals, once early mist along English Channel coasts disperses. Becoming locally rather warm in the southeast.

This evening/overnight: Showers across northern Scotland. Elsewhere generally dry, with evening sunny spells then overnight clear spells. Across northern areas localised ground frosts.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Thursday and Friday: Mainly dry, with sunny spells and just isolated light showers, except for more frequent showers across northwest Scotland on Thursday. Temperatures close to, or slightly above, average.
