

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Wednesday 25 Jun 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Outbreaks of rain across northern parts of the UK gradually becoming confined to northern Scotland through today. Further south scattered showers gradually dying away, allowing increasing amounts of sunshine to develop, with parts of southern England remaining dry. Generally windy. Temperatures near normal.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:
Thursday the far south of England is likely to remain dry, while becoming cloudy. Elsewhere outbreaks of rain, or showers, will become more extensive and locally heavy, although later Northern Ireland and western Scotland will become dry. Friday early rain clearing southern England, then showers here. Across the rest of the UK rain arriving from the west.
