

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Thursday 18 Dec 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Much of the south dry at first with some bright intervals. Cloud thickening with drizzle over Wales and western England by afternoon. Strong winds and rain over southern Scotland and Northern Ireland, moving southeast, weakening, and crossing the rest of the U.K. by late evening. Sunny or clear spells, wintry showers following to northern parts.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Wintry showers early Friday over northwest Scotland, elsewhere fine but very strong winds and heavy rain, preceded by snow on northern mountains, spreading across much of the U.K. Rain over central parts early Saturday moving north to leave the south dry, very mild but windy.
