

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
It will be fine across much of England and Wales today. It will also feel warmer than yesterday, with the best of the sunshine likely across southern counties. However, there will be thicker cloud elsewhere, with rain across parts of Scotland. Overnight, outbreaks of rain across Scotland will spread southwards, though much of southern England and Wales will remain dry.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:
Outbreaks of rain will tend to ease on Friday. Many areas will be fine, with some warm sunny spells, but the chance of some showers later. Fine for many again on Saturday, though rain will move into the northwest later.
