

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Tuesday 05 Jul 2011

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Cloud and rain in the west will gradually move eastwards during the day with freshening winds. Dry, warm and sunny for eastern parts until mid-afternoon, and clearing up later in the far west to sunshine and scattered showers. The rain becomes heavy across Scotland and eastern England overnight with a risk of thunder, but clear spells and scattered showers elsewhere.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Heavy rain continuing for parts of Scotland and northern England on Wednesday, with sunshine and scattered heavy, possibly thundery showers elsewhere. Also, becoming cloudier and windier towards the southwest later. Staying similar into Thursday with further sunshine and heavy showers.
