Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Early morning mist and fog in the south will slowly clear. Some bright or sunny spells will develop. Most areas continuing cold. Cloudier and milder in the northwest with some drizzle possible over hills. Overnight, England and Wales will continue dry, but remaining frosty with mist and fog patches reforming. Scotland and Northern Ireland will become cloudier, milder and breezier.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Heavy rain will spread across Northern Ireland and Scotland during the day, and to northern England later. England and Wales remaining dry and chilly with mist and bright spells. Sunday, milder with heavy rain and strong winds in all areas.
