General Situation

Pressure will remain high across Scotland, bringing mainly settled weather here. However further south a mainly east to northeasterly airflow will bring changeable conditions with showers, thundery and very heavy in places.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming northeasterly 4 or 5 for a time later in south.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less becoming east or northeast 3 to 5.

Slight, occasionally smooth.

Fair.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 4 at first in south, otherwise variable 3 or less, becoming easterly or southeasterly 3 to 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast 2 to 4, backing east or northeast 4 or 5 for a time in Firth of Forth.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Northeast veering east, 2 to 4.

24 hour forecast:

Slight or moderate.

Moderate, occasionally slight at first.

Showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 5 or 6, occasionally 4 in north.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair until later in north, otherwise showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 5 or 6 becoming cyclonic 3 to 5.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northeasterly 3 to 5 veering easterly or northeasterly 4 to 6, occasionally 7 in east.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 4 to 6 becoming variable 2 to 4, then southwesterly 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight for a time in west.

Showers, thundery at first.

Good, occasionally poor until later.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly 4 to 6, occasionally 7 at first, becoming variable 3 later in far west.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 3 to 5 becoming variable 3 or less, then southwest 4 or 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Showers, thundery at first.

Good, occasionally poor until later.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 3 to 5 veering east 4 to 6, becoming variable 2 to 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less becoming southwest 3 to 5.

Smooth or slight in east, slight or moderate in west.

Showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly 4 to 6, occasionally 7 in north, decreasing 3 at times in south.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in east.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or northeasterly 4 to 6 at first in north, otherwise variable 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first in north.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 4 to 6.

Smooth or slight in Cardigan Bay, slight or moderate elsewhere.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in north, then becoming cyclonic 3 to 5.

Slight or moderate in far north, smooth or slight elsewhere.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 4 to 6, becoming variable 2 to 4 for a time.

Smooth or slight close inshore in north, slight or moderate elsewhere.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, then becoming variable 3 at times except in Solway Firth.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Fair, then rain or showers in south.

Good, occasionally moderate in south.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 3 to 5.

Slight, occasionally moderate in south.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or northeast 3 to 5, becoming variable 2 to 4 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate in south.

Occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly 3 to 5, becoming variable 2 to 4 later in north.

Slight or moderate in south, smooth or slight in north.

Fair.

Easterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in south and in far north, becoming variable 2 at times in central areas.

Slight or moderate in south, smooth or slight in north.

General Situation

Westerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in north

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or southeasterly 3 to 5, occasionally 6 at first mid channel, becoming variable 1 or 2, locally calm for a time in the south of the area, becoming cyclonic 2 to 4, occasionally 5 later.
Mainly smooth in the south of the area, otherwise slight or moderate, becoming rather rough for a time at first mid channel, then a low swell developing later. Showers, locally heavy and thundery, mostly clearing by mid morning, fog patches for a time at first.
Good, occasionally moderate, locally poor, becoming moderate to very poor for a time at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic 2 to 4, becoming northerly or northwesterly 3 to 5 around dawn, backing westerly or southwesterly, becoming variable 1 to 3 for a time later in the far south of the area.
Moderate at first mid channel, otherwise smooth or slight with a low swell at first.
Occasional rain or drizzle with fog banks for a time at first, isolated showers later.
Good, becoming moderate to very poor for a time at first, occasionally moderate later.

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
