Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Outbreaks of rain will become quite persistent across much of southern Britain, but it may become brighter although very windy in the far south. Scotland and Northern Ireland will be generally bright, with scattered sharp showers, mainly in the west.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Early cloud and rain in southern England becoming confined to the far southeast by Thursday afternoon. Elsewhere some sunshine, but also bands of heavy showers spreading southeast. Windy with gales developing in northwest Scotland. Showers persisting through Friday, these frequent and occasionally heavy and thundery in the west. They will also fall as sleet or snow over some northern hills.
