Headline:

Chilly night in the south. Rain spreading to many places.

This Evening and Tonight:

Rain spreading to many northern areas. Further south, dry, clear and chilly. Local ground-frost.

Saturday:

Central and southern areas starting dry and bright. Rain across northern areas spreading southeastwards, though the southwest may remain dry. Drier across Scotland for a time.

Outlook for Sunday:

Rain clearing to squally showers across Scotland and Northern Ireland. Risk severe gales. England and Wales, mostly dry, but cloudy.
