

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Predominantly cloudy with spells of mainly light rain, although the cloud may be thin enough at times for some brighter intervals. Northern areas will feel quite chilly in brisk easterly winds, but winds will be lighter further south. Hill fog will become fairly extensive in southern Britain today and then more widely overnight.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Both days continuing mainly cloudy and damp with hill fog and sporadic light rain, although, on Friday, southern Britain may see some heavier rain for a time. Becoming colder from the northeast, with an increasing chance of snow on Scottish high ground. Northern areas staying quite windy.
