

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Scotland, Northern Ireland and northern England will see plenty of blustery showers, some heavy this afternoon. Elsewhere, a scattering of mainly light showers are expected, although some southern counties staying dry. Feeling fresh, especially in strong winds across Scotland. Much of the UK becoming dry overnight, with winds easing, but further rain for northwest Scotland by dawn.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Much of England and Wales dry on Tuesday, however strong winds and rain, heavy at times, will affect Northern Ireland, Scotland, west Wales and northwest England, slipping southeastwards and fragmenting during Wednesday. Blustery showers following for northwestern areas with temperatures generally near normal.
