Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Many central and southern areas starting frosty with patchy fog, but this clearing to leave some sunshine. A band of organised rain across northern England spreading southwards across the rest of England and Wales, though the far southeast remaining dry. Sunnier skies, but with scattered wintry showers across Scotland and Northern Ireland following the rain southwards. Remaining rather cold.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Rain will clear the southeast Monday night, then Tuesday and Wednesday will have clear or sunny spells and scattered wintry showers, these heaviest and most frequent around northern and western coasts. Remaining cold and windy with frost night and morning.
