

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Tuesday 14 Oct 2014

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Occasional rain over central/eastern areas, gradually fragmenting, but persistent rain and a raw feel for east/northeast England. Fine with sunshine in the northwest. Sunnier interludes in the south may trigger heavy showers later, particularly across East Anglia. Cloudy overnight in the south. Clear spells in the north. Winds increasing with rain arriving in the southwest later.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Wednesday; rain, locally heavy, moves northeastwards from the southwest with sunshine and heavy, possibly thundery, showers following. Elsewhere, mainly dry with sunny spells and isolated showers after morning mist. Rain moving erratically northeastwards across the north on Thursday with sunny spells and showers following.
