

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A risk of ice across northeast Britain this morning, but overnight rain and snow will steadily become confined to northeast Scotland. Elsewhere, a sunny afternoon, though plenty of showers will affect western areas. Overnight, northeast Scotland will remain damp, and showers will continue in the west, but under clear skies elsewhere, there is a risk of frost and ice reforming.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Remaining cold and showery on both Tuesday and Wednesday, with showers becoming increasingly wintry in nature, especially across high ground in the north and east. Where skies clear overnight, there is a continued risk of frost and icy stretches developing.
