Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Outbreaks of rain over many western and northern areas this morning will be heavy at times. Northern areas will become brighter and showery this afternoon with some sunny intervals. Amounts of rain over central and eastern parts of England will be mostly small. It'll be another very mild day but the strong winds will make it feel colder. Severe gales are likely in the northwest.  
Tonight, northern areas will be generally dry and a little colder, while the south stays mild with further rain at times.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:  
Staying mild and very changeable with further rain and strong winds at times.
