

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain across northern areas will push south, reaching central areas by evening. Colder conditions will follow with wintry showers in the far northwest. Southern parts will be warmer with sunshine and scattered showers. Overnight, the rain will move southeastwards, reaching all parts by dawn. It will turn clear and cold behind the rainband with wintry showers in the far northwest.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

The rain will affect southeast England throughout Sunday, clearing through the evening. Skies will be sunnier elsewhere but with scattered showers in the north. The showery theme will continue into Monday and it will stay rather cold and breezy throughout.
