Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Generally dry and bright for most, but still a few showers likely. Showers heavier and more frequent in the northwest this evening with heavy persistent rain arriving across southwestern parts. Rain spreading east across Wales and into southern and central England overnight. Drier elsewhere with scattered showers. Gales developing along southern English county coasts.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Southern and central England along with Wales will continue to see outbreaks of rain on Friday, becoming heavy once again later. Scattered showers elsewhere, heaviest across western Scotland. Much drier and brighter for all on Saturday, with a few showers continuing across the northeast of Scotland.
