at 1945 on Thursday 03 Jan 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Early snow will clear northeastern Scotland then it will turn brighter here.  
Elsewhere will be rather cloudy and dull, though occasional brighter spells are possible. It will gradually turn less cold from the south, but a band of rain, preceded by sleet and snow over N.Ireland and upland Scotland will push in from the west, across most parts by evening.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Milder and often breezy across the whole of the UK but still the risk of snow at times over the Scottish mountains. Generally unsettled with bands of rain or showers at times, but also some brighter intervals particularly on Sunday.
