Headline:

Showers or periods rain/sleet/snow, persistent at times, especially over SE.England/E.Anglia.

Today:

England and Wales, rain/sleet/snow, even at low levels, especially in southeastern areas later. Scotland and Northern Ireland, sunny spells and wintry showers, frequent and heavy across northeast Scotland bringing locally significant accumulations.

Tonight:

Sleet/snow continuing in the southeast. Wintry showers in north and east. Frosty.

Outlook for Thursday:

Sleet/snow in the southeast and wintry showers in north/east, dying out. Rain/sleet spreading from northwest later.
