Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
Rain across Shetland will clear away, then all areas will have bright or sunny spells. The best of the sunshine is likely to be in the south and east where many places should remain dry. However, showers are likely in the north and parts of the west, these heavy for a time across western Scotland. It will still be fairly mild, but rather windy, though winds will be less strong than on Thursday.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Remaining unsettled with showers or longer spells of rain, though with some drier, brighter spells too, these especially in the south and east.
