Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
Overnight snow will persist in Kent and possibly E.Sussex during the morning, with possible further disruption there, but should peter out in the afternoon. Rain will spread across north and west Scotland and N.Ireland. Otherwise mainly dry with sunny spells after a frosty and icy start. Cold.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Cloud and rain/sleet, possibly snow, over southern England will clear southwards around lunchtime on Friday. Otherwise sunny spells and isolated wintry showers. Rather cloudy with wintry showers and a cold northeasterly wind over southern and eastern England on Saturday. Sunnier elsewhere, but some wintry showers are likely over eastern coasts. Generally cold.
