Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Snow showers will continue in northern and western parts today, but are likely to fall as rain or sleet in coastal areas, and also across southwest England. Elsewhere it will be sunny, cold and dry. Tonight, icy stretches will form where surfaces are wet or still covered in snow.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Sunday will see persistent rain, sleet or snow, with potential for large accumulations in central parts, and there will be gales in places. Scotland will be mainly dry and bright. Monday will be windy in the south, with snow possible across central and southern parts, but sunshine and showers further north.
