Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Most places generally cloudy with rain at times, especially in the north and west where hills will be shrouded in fog. Brighter at times in the east and later the south, and here becoming warm. Becoming rather windy. Tonight, many places dry, but showery rain likely in the west. It will be very mild.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Most places cloud on Good Friday with rain becoming more widespread across central and eastern areas. Western areas will become brighter with some hazy sunshine. Rain clearing eastwards Friday night, then Saturday will have sunshine and slow moving heavy showers. Feeling warm in sunshine.
