Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
Cloud and drizzly rain across Wales, central and southern England will clear from the north, though the far south and southwest of England are likely to remain cloudy and damp. Otherwise, it will be dry with sunny spells, any remaining showers in the far north will die out, and western areas will turn cloudier during the afternoon. It will be fairly mild, but strong winds in the north will ease.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:
Scotland and Northern Ireland will be wet and windy on Monday, but should be bright and breezy on Tuesday. England and Wales will remain cloudy and quiet with overnight fog perhaps slow to clear in places.
