Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Largely dry, sunny and very warm today. Cloudy and showery over N.Ireland. Scattered showers over Scotland, especially this morning. Showery rain, sometimes heavy and thundery, will affect N.Ireland and western Britain this evening, turning lighter and more showery as it pushes over eastern parts tonight. Otherwise largely dry.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Showers are expected across Scotland, N.Ireland and eastern England, especially initially on Friday. Otherwise dry and sunny. Generally rather warm. Cloudy with showery outbreaks of rain for most on Saturday, although eastern Scotland and southern England should gradually become dry with sunny spells. Temperatures mostly around normal, rather warm over eastern England.
