Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Sunshine and scattered showers for most, best of the brightness in northeast. A spell of persistent and occasionally heavy rain moving east across southern and central parts through the day. Cool. Further rain returning to the southwest by evening, clearing overnight. Showers dying out overnight, becoming cold with frost in places under clear skies with light winds.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Cold, bright and sunny start to Sunday, but turning wet, windy and milder from the west through the evening and overnight. Rain on Monday clearing to the southeast through the day, lingering across the south overnight. Blustery showers following in the northwest, turning colder.
