

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
After a bright start for Scotland, cloud and rain will spread into western parts as winds strengthen. Elsewhere it will be overcast but dry with early fog patches slowly clearing. Feeling less cold than recent days. We hold on to the cloud overnight, as rain edges into Scotland and Northern Ireland, but for all it will remain frost free.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Outbreaks of rain will erratically spread southwards on Wednesday, although many will remain dry with some sunshine developing through the afternoon. Further rain is likely in the south on Thursday, although it should remain drier elsewhere with some more sunshine.
