Headline:

Scotland patchy rain, snow gradually dying away. Elsewhere rain/strong winds.

Today:

England/Wales/Northern Ireland: often heavy rain, and strong locally gale force winds, spreading northeast. Drier later across parts of central England and south Wales. Scotland outbreaks of rain, snow in far north gradually dying away.

Tonight:

Becoming drier across the UK, except for western coastal showers, before further rain and local gales reaches England, Wales and N.Ireland.

Outlook for Monday:

Mild, windy, rain spreading northeast.
