Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Northern and central Scotland, Northern Ireland and southern England and Wales will have a sunny but cold start to the day. There will be showers elsewhere, and these become widespread during the morning and afternoon and may fall as sleet or wet snow on higher ground in the north. The best of any sunshine will be found in coastal areas.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

It remains unsettled on Thursday and Friday, with further showers or longer periods of rain expected, some of which will be heavy at times. Southeastern parts are likely to remain driest and brightest but even here, some showers are possible.
