Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A chilly start this morning with the risk of ice. Cloud will thicken across southern England, with some rain in the south-east, meanwhile, showers will affect coastal parts making little inland progress, but many will be dry with some sunny spells. Tonight, it will turn dry with clear spells, leading to a widespread frost and some pockets of fog.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Monday starts fine although icy and foggy in places, as rain and strengthening winds, already in Northern Ireland, moves slowly eastwards, although not reaching eastern counties. Turning drier and brighter from the west on Tuesday, although remaining wet in the east.
