Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Mostly sunny across England and Wales today, with temperatures around or just below normal. Cold tonight with clear spells. Cool, breezy conditions, cloud and rain will spread southwards across Scotland, N.Ireland and northwest England during today and tonight with showers developing over northern Scotland.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Cloud and rain will push south across central parts of the UK on Thursday, with blustery, sometimes wintry showers in the north. Fine over southern parts. That rain will clear southwards during Friday with sunny spells and showers becoming widespread. Windy with wintry showers over northern parts. Rather cold generally, temperatures around normal in the south.
