Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Sunday: Eastern coasts, mostly cloudy, with mist/fog patches.
Otherwise mainly dry with some good spells of sunshine, although
starting off cloudy in east. Risk of showers N.Ireland/SW.England.
Generally warm, very warm/hot, southern England/south Wales.

Sunday evening/night:-Eastern coastal areas mostly overcast with some
mist/fog patches, drizzle in places. Otherwise dry with clear spells,
although some showers possible in far northwest for a time. Scattered
thunderly showers in SW.England spreading north to affect W.Wales.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:
Scattered thunderly showers in west on Monday. Dry in east, with sunny
spells. Thunderly showers for all on Tuesday, risk of torrential
downpours. Warm or very warm.
