General Situation

Pressure will remain high over the north, maintaining settled weather here. However in south thundery troughs and lows are expected during the next couple of days.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 4 or less becoming east or northeast 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 2 to 4.

East backing northeast, 3 or 4.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 3 or 4, increasing 4 or 5 later.

Slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Fair.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or northeast 4 or 5, backing north or northeast 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight or moderate becoming moderate.

Rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 4 to 6, becoming cyclonic 4 or 5, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Moderate, becoming slight except in north.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 5 or 6, becoming cyclonic 3 to 5.

Moderate, occasionally slight in the wash and Thames estuary.

Rain or showers, perhaps thundery in south.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic 3 to 5, becoming southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth later in the wash and Thames estuary.

Rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 5 or 6, becoming cyclonic 3 or 4, then southwesterly 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight in west.

Rain or showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in east.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth at first in west.

Showers.

Good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 4 to 6, becoming variable 3 or less, then southwest 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight.

Rain or showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight becoming slight, occasionally moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 4 to 6 becoming variable 4 or less, then southwest 4 or 5 later.

Moderate becoming slight, then smooth in lyme bay.

Rain or showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5 backing south or southeast 3 or 4.

Slight becoming slight or moderate, but smooth at first in lyme bay.

Showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 5 to 7 veering east or southeast, becoming cyclonic later, 2 to 4.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight.

Rain or showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic 2 to 4 becoming southwest 3 to 5, then variable 2 to 4 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in west.

Rain or thundery showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
East or northeast 3 to 5, occasionally 6 at first.
Slight or moderate becoming smooth or slight.
Rain or showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
East or northeast 3 to 5 becoming cyclonic 2 to 4.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first in northwest.
Rain or showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway
24 hour forecast:
East or northeast 3 to 5.
Smooth or slight.
Rain or showers later in south.
Good, occasionally moderate later in south.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
East or northeast 3 or 4, increasing 4 to 6 for a time.
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate for a time in north.
Rain or showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Easterly or northeasterly, becoming variable for a time, 2 to 4, increasing 4 or 5 for a time later.

Easterly or northeasterly, becoming variable for a time, 2 to 4, increasing 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in North Channel.

Variable becoming northeast, veering east, 2 to 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Variable 3 or less becoming northeast 3 or 4.

North or northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, becoming variable 4 or less, then cyclonic 3 to 5 later.

Slight, occasionally smooth in southeast.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Ridge of high pressure gradually extending from the south.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil

Westerly 2 to 4, occasionally 5 in north

Slight occasionally moderate in north, but smooth in lee shelter

Mainly fair

Mainly good

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Sunday 05 Jun until 1200 UTC on Sunday 05 Jun:

West 2 or 3, occasionally 4 at first

Slight occasionally moderate at first in north, but smooth in lee shelter

Mainly fair

Mainly good

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East to northeast 3 to 5, perhaps occasionally 6 mid-channel at first, becoming cyclonic this evening then westerly by dawn, backing southwest later.

Smooth or slight in the south, moderate in the north for a time at first.

Showers, mainly from evening, locally heavy with a risk of thunder, mostly clearing later mist and a risk of fog patches clearing later.

Good, occasionally moderate, locally poor or perhaps very poor at times.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 3 to 5, locally variable 1 to 3 in the far south of the area for a time, becoming generally southerly later.

Slight, locally smooth at times.

Rain and drizzle with mist and risk of fog, after dawn.

Good, becoming moderate to poor later, perhaps locally very poor.
