General Situation

Pressure will remain high over the north, maintaining settled weather here. Elsewhere various lows and troughs will bring rain or showers. An Atlantic low will then move over Ireland later on Tuesday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast, backing east or northeast, 3 to 5.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or northeast 3 to 5, occasionally 6 later near Cape Wrath.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight, occasionally moderate in northwest.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 2 or 3, backing north or northeast 3 to 5.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 3 to 5, veering east or northeast 2 to 4 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Showers.

Good.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 3 or 4, backing north or northwest 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain at first.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest 4 or 5, decreasing 2 or 3 later, then veering east or southeast 2 to 4.

Moderate becoming slight.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast, backing northwest, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Moderate, becoming slight or moderate.

Rain at first.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 3 to 5, becoming variable 3 or less, then southeast 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming slight.

Occasional rain or drizzle, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 2 to 4, increasing 4 or 5, becoming westerly 2 to 4 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight in south.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or northwesterly, becoming variable, 2 to 4, then southwesterly 4 or 5 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first in northeast.

Rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 4 to 6, becoming variable 2 to 4 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate, becoming smooth or slight later.

Showers, perhaps thundery later in west.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming southwesterly 4 or 5 later, then backing southerly 4 to 6.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later in west.

Rain or thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 3 to 5, becoming variable 2 to 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming south or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Showers, fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Southwest backing east or southeast 2 to 4, occasionally 5 for a time in lyme bay, becoming variable later.

Slight, occasionally smooth in lyme bay and moderate in southwest.

Showers, perhaps thundery later.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming south or southwest 4 to 6 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth at first in lyme bay, becoming moderate or rough later in west.

Rain later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later in southwest.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming southerly or southwesterly 4 to 6, occasionally 7 later in far southwest.

Smooth or slight in east until later, otherwise slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later in far west.

Rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

Easterly 4 or 5 at first in far north, otherwise variable 3 or less.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, becoming south or southeast 4 to 6 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 3 to 5, becoming variable 4 or less.

Smooth or slight, becoming smooth.

Rain or showers at first.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 4 or less, becoming east or southeast 4 to 6 later.

Smooth, becoming smooth or slight later.

Rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Mainly slight at first, becoming smooth or slight.

Occasional rain at first.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, becoming southeast 4 or 5 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Rain later.

Mainly good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

Variable 4 or less.

Smooth, occasionally slight in far south.

Showers at first.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 4 or less, becoming east or southeast 3 to 5.

Smooth, becoming smooth or slight.

Rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

Variable 2 to 4.

Smooth.

Variable 4 or less at first in south, otherwise easterly or northeasterly 3 to 5, occasionally 6 later in north.

Shetland Isles

General Situation
High pressure across Shetland Waters will drift slowly northwestwards during Monday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil

Variable 3 or less
Slight, but smooth in lee shelter just east of Shetland
Fair
Good

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Monday 06 Jun until 0000 UTC on Tuesday 07 Jun:

Variable 3 or less becoming northeast 3 or 4.
Slight, but smooth in lee shelter just east of Shetland
Mainly fair
Good

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 3 to 4, backing south to southeast 2 to 4 during the morning, occasionally 5 late afternoon, then veering southwest by dusk.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional rain, drizzle, mist and a risk of fog patches in the southwest from late morning, spreading northeastward.

Good, becoming moderate to poor, perhaps very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly 3 to 5, backing southerly during the afternoon, increasing 4 to 6 by dusk.

Smooth or slight, with a low swell, increasing slight to moderate, locally rather rough in the northwest, later.

Occasional rain and drizzle, locally heavy later, with mist and a risk of fog patches, especially until mid-morning.

Moderate to good, occasionally poor, perhaps very poor.

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
