Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
It will be a cold day with some sunny spells. There'll be a few sleet or snow showers across eastern areas, these becoming more frequent in the far southeast later where there'll also be a brisk wind. Overnight sleet and snow showers will continue in the southeast. Elsewhere it will be dry with a hard frost developing.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Wintry showers in the east and southeast at first on Monday will gradually die away leaving some sunshine. Elsewhere largely dry and sunny after a very cold start. On Tuesday showery outbreaks of sleet and snow move southeast across all parts.
