

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rather cloudy with rain, heavy at times across the south today, although some brighter interludes will develop in places during the afternoon. Further north will be largely dry with sunny spells, once any patchy fog and low cloud clears. Overnight the rain slowly becomes restricted to southwestern parts, leaving a largely dry but chilly night with clear spells elsewhere.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:
South and southwestern areas of the UK are expected to remain rather cloudy with further rain and drizzle throughout Tuesday and much of Wednesday. Largely dry elsewhere though with sunshine by day but chilly by night with mist and fog patches.
