Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
After a frosty start eastern areas will remain dry throughout, although sunshine will gradually fade. Rain will move into Northern Ireland during the morning and will spread into western parts of Britain later, with snow on northern hills. Tonight there will be a spell of rain, with sleet and snow in many northern areas.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

On Wednesday rain in the east will soon clear away into the North Sea but further rain and showers will follow from the southwest. It will be generally rather cloudy, although some sunshine is likely in places. Thursday, windy with showers or longer spells of rain.
