

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Tuesday 06 Mar 2007

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Southeast England and East Anglia will see some rain at first this morning but this should continue to move away to allow generally dry, bright conditions across many places, and feeling pleasant enough. Some showers will develop later, these most likely over western districts where some could be thundery. Showers likely this evening, too, but becoming generally dry after midnight.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Plenty of dry, bright weather on Wednesday, although some rain is likely across parts of the far south and southwest whilst showers are expected over western Scotland. Dry and bright initially on Thursday but rain arriving from the west later.
