Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
Many places will start wet with prolonged and locally heavy rain, especially in the south and southwest where localised flooding is possible. However, brighter weather with sunshine and showers, already across Northern Ireland will spread to much of Scotland and northwest England during the morning, then onto all but southeast England by evening. It will feel cool in strong winds, these reaching gale force at times in the northwest.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Apart from showers near southern and western coasts, much of Monday will be dry with some sunshine. However, heavy rain and strong winds reaching northwestern areas later in the day will spread to all areas on Tuesday.
