Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain and fairly strong winds will affect Scotland, western England and Wales for much of the day, though clearing Northern Ireland early on. It will tend to turn more showery across Scotland this afternoon. Further heavy rain is expected for southwest England, Wales and parts of northern England this evening and overnight. Bright and very warm in southeast England.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

On Friday further rain may affect southern and central areas of England with a scattering of showers elsewhere. Many areas dry on Saturday, but showers in the northwest. Windy in northwestern parts throughout. Temperatures near normal, but warm in the sunshine.
